ENROLMENTS FOR 2022: Keep them coming in !!!!

To enrol at St Mary MacKillop Catholic School you are required to provide the following:

- A completed pre-enrolment form signed by both parents (which is available at our School Office or on our school website)

- A Preference Certificate signed by a Catholic Priest and stamped with a parish stamp. - Original birth certificate or passport

- Original baptism certificate - A passport must be sighted showing the residency status of a child who is born outside of New Zealand

- Immunisation certificate.
