Welcome to Term 4. A very different one to what we imagined at the beginning of the year. We have decided to send out a newsletter in Term 4 as a way to make sure we are getting all our communications out and we keep a routine and some regularity towards the end of the year.

We are proud of how our community has responded to this outbreak, but the mahi isn't yet done. Please continue to follow all the alert level requirements including staying at home and getting tested for COVID-19.

Following the Government's announcement that plans are underway to support the return to onsite learning for our schools who are in Alert Level 3 areas and to do this in a way that is as safe as possible. The restrictions of Alert Level 3 and 4 have been a real challenge to the wellbeing of our tamariki and whānau and we have heard from many of you that your tamariki are keen to see their friends and teachers kanohi ki te kanohi.

You can be reassured that any decisions about bringing more children and staff on-site will be done in accordance with strict public health guidance – so what on-site learning will look like will be different than Alert Level 2 or Alert Level 1 settings.

The earliest a return to school will happen is 15 November, and we will provide more information about this closer to the time.

Mandate for Education:

You will also see plenty in the media at the moment around a new mandate for Education and working in schools. It requires any worker onsite to have received their first Jab by November 15. It is now legally required that we hold a COVID-19 vaccination register for all staff. Staff with only one jab will be required to COVID test once a week until fully vaccinated. We are moving toward having 100 percent of our staff vaccinated – so we are all playing our part in keeping our community safe.

Turf:

We have had an exciting development at school with our new Tiger turf well under way. It will mean a greater playing area on the CPOD and DPOD side. Next year we will be replacing the turf on the A and B Pod side.

ENROLMENTS FOR 2022: Keep them coming in !!!!

Parents are invited to enrol their children at St Mary MacKillop Catholic School when they turn three, and I strongly advise not to leave this to the last minute even if you have children already attending our school. Preference is given to children who are baptised Catholic.

To enrol at St Mary MacKillop Catholic School you are required to provide the following:

- A completed pre-enrolment form signed by both parents (which is available at our School Office or on our school website)
- A Preference Certificate signed by a Catholic Priest and stamped with a parish stamp. Original birth certificate or passport
- Original baptism certificate A passport must be sighted showing the residency status of a child who is born outside of New Zealand


