Sacrament programme at St Therese:

- Candidate to have received the Sacrament of Baptism. (Please bring along a copy of Baptismal Certificate for enrolment if baptised in another Parish).
- Candidate to have completed 7 years of age as on 30th September 2017.
 (Please bring copy of Birth Certificate).
- One Parent or God-Parent should be present with the candidate during the programme.
- Candidates need to have 90% attendance and knowledge of basic prayers at the end of the programme to be eligible to receive the Sacraments.
