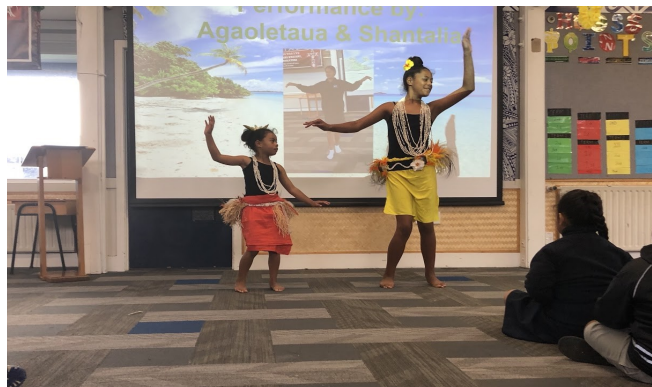
In Term 3 we plan to use our energy and commitment to have our first educators come into school this term and take something home with them.
