Covid Protection Framework: Orange Term 2 Reminders

As emailed in the end of the school holidays:

- The school timetable is running with all pods on one timetable
- Children and Staff are <u>strongly encouraged</u> to continue to wear masks for all classes inside.
- Visitors/Parent can come on site, we ask you to wear a mask

The removal of restrictions on indoor gathering sizes means that events can now take place. We will message closer to the time around what is happening.

Mask wearing is strongly recommended for inside gatherings

Ventilation:

- Doors and windows open to ensure ventilation of spaces.
- When leaving the classroom during the day ensure doors and windows remain open.
- We take opportunities to go outside weather appropriate
- On cold days ventilation can be achieved through doors and windows partially open
- Air Purifiers will operate in all learning spaces



Keep up the Communication:

If your child returns a positive COVID-19 test result please continue to let us know.

We are continuing to work with the Covid Response Team from the Ministry of Education and updating our school's information spreadsheet.

A reminder that the isolation period for people who test positive for Covid19, and for household contacts, is 7 days.

Please ensure you notify <u>mikep@marymackillop.school.nz</u> or <u>marthal@marymackillop.school.nz</u> if your child tests positive for Covid19, or is a household contact.

Updating your contact details is very important for communication between school and home. If you have changed your home address, email or phone number please let the office know asap.


