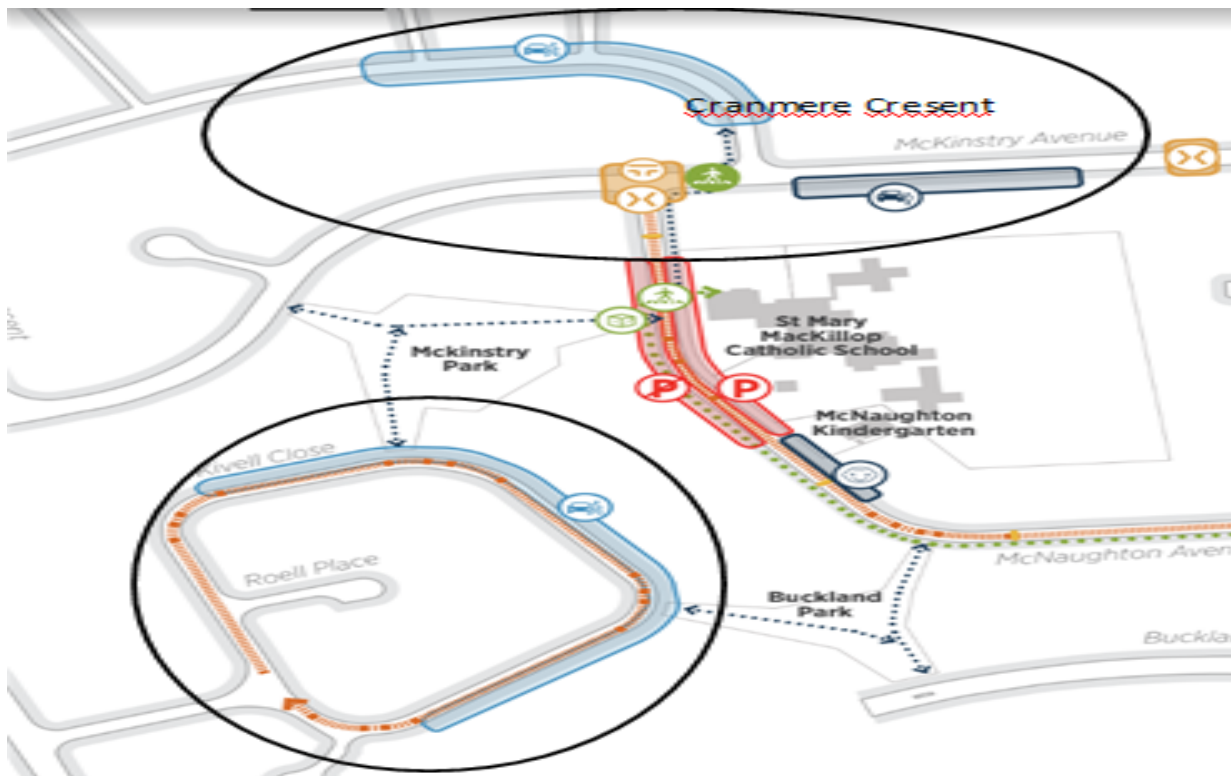
Lunches:
