
### Uniform check :

#### Attendance at School:

It is important that your child attends school. Any child who goes on holiday in term time must visit the principal to discuss this.

Attendance is of concern when there is :

- 1. unexplained non attendance
- 2. a pattern of non-attendance is noted by the teacher or office staff
- 3. the student has not attended for more than 5 out of 10 days

When there is a concern the Teacher or Principal contacts the family or visits the home. As a school we analyse attendance and lateness and compile summary reports. Sending letters home outlining the concern and the importance of regular attendance and also requiring a meeting at school.

#### Enrolments: 2023

Parents are invited to enrol their children at St Mary MacKillop Catholic School when they turn three, and I strongly advise not to leave this to the last minute even if you have children already attending our school.

Preference is given to children who are baptised Catholic.

To enrol at St Mary MacKillop Catholic School you are required to provide the following: - A completed pre-enrolment form signed by both parents (which is available at our School Office or on our school website) - A Preference Certificate signed by a Catholic Priest and stamped with a parish stamp. - Original birth certificate or passport - Original baptism certificate - A passport must be sighted showing the residency status of a child who is born outside of New Zealand - Immunisation certificate.

There will be an Enrolment Information morning on Wednesday 9th November at 9.30am in our school library for those students who have enrolled for 2023 and have received a letter.
