#### Road Works on McNaughton Ave Jan - Feb 2024

Safe and Healthy School Streets - South Auckland (SHSSA) - permanent infrastructure installation

For the past 2 years Auckland Transport has trialed the Safe and Healthy School Streets - South Auckland (SHSSA) programme at St Mary MacKillop Catholic School. Over this time we have seen a significant improvement in the reduction of traffic congestion outside our school making it much safer for our tamariki.

Next year Auckland Transport will be replacing the temporary road structures with permanent infrastructure. During the installation phase there will be very limited vehicle access to the school on McNaughton Ave.



There will be designated "Park and Walk" areas on McKinstry Ave, Cranmere Cres and Kivel Close where you will be able to park and walk the short distance to school. We encourage all families to continue to use these "Park and Walk" spots even after road works have been completed to ensure that we maintain safe access for your students coming to and from school.
